TOWN OFFICE: Our new summer hours for the office are: 7:15 a.m. until noon and 1:00 p.m. until 5:00 p.m.

Please be sure and check with the town clerk to see if a building permit is required for your project at your residence. Building permits are required to install sprinkler systems in your yard also.

POLICE DEPARTMENT: A few parking issues have arisen over the past few weeks in reference to vehicles and trailers/campers parked near intersections.

Sinclair ordinance 7-4-2 (D) States no vehicle, bus, motor home, camper, boat, other recreational vehicle or trailer of any type shall be parked upon any street or roadway within <u>15 feet</u> of the intersection.

This is for everyone's safety. With our narrow streets and uncontrolled intersections it is important to be able to see any oncoming traffic at the intersections.

CODE ENFORCEMENT: We have a number of residences in Sinclair who have appliances stored outdoors. We have 2 ordinances that address this.

Ordinance 5-1-2 (J) Junk and litter prohibits any iron, glass, paper, rags, cordage, machinery parts, or <u>other waste or discarded material of any nature or substance whatsoever</u>. This would include appliances.

Ordinance 6-4-2 Abandoned iceboxes or refrigerators. Iceboxes include freezers and are prohibited from being stored outside. Part of the ordinance does permit working freezers and refrigerators to be kept outside as long as they are secured with a lock to prevent children from getting into them.

STREETS & PARKS DEPARTMENT: The new playground equipment in Washington Park has been completed and is open to the public. We had to wait until the weather permitted to have the base poured.

The dedication ceremony for the playground is scheduled for Saturday, August 24, 2019. Please watch for flyers with events being scheduled for that day. We will have food vendors and a concert in the park. Everyone is invited.
