POLICE DEPARTMENT: It's been a hot dry summer and your police department has been busy with the increased traffic from the turnaround and regular summer tourists. With the month of August here we would like to remind everyone that school will be starting on August 19th. The bus stop locations will be the same as in previous years, on Cleveland Ave. at the school and on N. 5th Street at the Post office.

CODE ENFORCEMENT: We are still having an issue with weeds and grasses over 8 inches tall. Our town code prohibits them and does include a fine for non-compliance. Keeping our grass and weeds short not only keeps our town looking good but helps with the control of pests such as mice and mosquitos. We have also noticed an increase in the amount of junk and other items prohibited by code on properties. This also helps with the pest issue. LANDFILL: The Maintenance Department asks if you use the landfill to please shut the gate. The gate has been found open and the cattle have found their way in.
