Johansson shared that Room 3 is the room the art group uses 1 pm to 4 pm Monday thru Thursday and 5 pm to 10 pm on Fridays.

Room 4 & 5 is the current community room that the seniors have coffee and donuts on Wednesdays from 9 am to 11 am.

Room 6 is where the quilters are from 2 pm to 5 pm on Wednesdays.

Room 8 is the gladiator boxing club who use their room and the gym on Monday, Tuesday and Thursday from 6 pm thru 7:30 pm. With being in season from June to October and the off season from October to May.

Room 2 is for the ham radio club which use their room once a month on Thursday at 7 pm.

Room 1 is the office at the school and the Masons from the Blue Lodge would like to start using the office. The Schedule would be every 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Wednesday at 7 pm and Thursday at 7 pm. With some Saturday time and Sunday at 2 pm and 5:30 pm.

Room 7 which is available, and Steve Sondergard would like to use the room times to be determined. Steve would also like to use the gym and share with the boxing club. Steve would also like to use the community room which is room 4 & 5 as well time to be determined. This would mean the senior coffee and donuts would need to be moved somewhere else. The Masons are willing to share their room with the seniors so long as everyone respects the Masons stuff.

Steve Sondergard would like to use these open rooms to have an escape room. These rooms would be educational and would be for all ages but really hoping to help kids with learning in a creative way.

It was also discussed possibly having Comtronix doing a burglar alarm system as well as key card access.
