Mayor Cullen Meeks called the workshop to order at 5:01 p.m. to discuss water rates changes for the Town of Sinclair. The Council increased the water rates for the Town of Sinclair as the City of Rawlins has increased the water rates for its customers which includes the Town of Sinclair. The council increase the water rates by 16.6% as that is how much the rate increased from the previous rate. This rate was applied to the water rate tiers and if the amount was not to the closest nickel that amount was rounded up to the closest nickel. Example \$6.12 rounded to \$6.15.

The Council also increased the Water Fill Station rates. Commercial is \$7.00 per 1000 gallons, in town residents at fill station is \$2.10 per 1000 gallons and residents outside of town limits is \$2.45 per 1000 gallons.

Mayor Meeks adjourned the workshop at 6:05 p.m.
